- 1) There's a new Seneschale in town.
- 2) Goldkey is officially under new management.
- 3) Bids still needed for events.
- 4) Cloverdale has been booked for the next six months, we need 16 people at each practice to break even, but things are looking good for attendance.
- 5) Lions Gate submitted the financial policy in June, to the principality for approval, but haven't heard back. They may rework a few things now.

James: At 12th Night it was confirmed that a barony can only have three events on the kingdom calendar (level 1 events). You need a minimum of one level 1 event a year, to hold baronial status, but you can't exceed three. This doesn't stop you from having more events (level 2 or 3), just not more level 1.

Ceara: TirRigh is in the process of rewriting their calendar policy, so that each group (shire, barony) can keep one weekend as "theirs." Traditionally, the August Long Weekend has "belonged" to Lions gate.

There was some confusion between Morweena and Anika, and the hall has been paid for except for the deposit. Wulfstan and Bernie will be hosting a party, with Anika running a tavern. As it is a catering hall, and we have a cash bar, no outside alcohol is allowed. Still working out the schedules, and their majesties would like to come. Rapier would have to have a tourney on Sat. We have access to the kitchen, purely to get water for the fighters. No other use of the kitchen is permitted.

Further discussion about lay-out of ready rooms, and needing assistance with gate. Ylas volunteered to run gate. Wendy volunteered to assist (in alternation with Watch duties).

Callen has agreed to come back for another year! There still needs to be consultation on how it will be named. Callen would also like a deputy, with an eye to that deputy becoming Event Steward next year, with Callen shadowing him/her as needed.

We had approximately 300 in attendance last year, estimates maybe closer to 400 this year. We still need to work out our budget.

Some discussion on extending the length of the event. The park is available from the Wednesday to the Monday encompassing the August Long Weekend. We don't need to book all of it, but it's available for our use should we desire it to be. Options include a more leisurely set-up, or an extension of the event with classes on the week days, and the main fighting on the weekend.

There was much support for the extension of the event.

Kevin also suggested having their majesties talk to Lionsdale and formally request the use of a portion of their lands.
