On the concept of themed events, We would like to see the Bransle themed for each one. If you have an idea for Us, please present it, and host it! As well, feedback to the Coronet is important, give Us feedback, especially for those that deserve awards. A new A&S award will be developed, the Baronial Warrant (by appointment to). This is being researched, and may be ready for the end of this year. The idea is a craftsman who makes multiple items...and it will expire, when We step down, and will have to be renewed by Or successors.

Recommendations will come from the populace to Us. The Warrant will NOT be exclusive (there can be a dozen Baronial potters, for example).

Her Excellency was happy to be here today, and had pie. She is amused.

Other Business:

Past Events

TOA – it's 11 months away, and I am sure it will be fantastic! Alright, the last event went well. Some money came in, some money will come out to pay poor Callen for his expenses. A detailed (45 page, 10pt font) report was submitted. Ok, six pages, at 12pt. We had almost twice the number of fighters on the field – over half the attendees were involved in a martial activity of some kind! Setup went well, despite the short notice move. Now, talking money - revenue was \$6,340, expenses were \$5,280, NMS was \$575. Budgeted profit was \$1,100, we actually made \$475 (with gate being “over” by \$43.00). With site change increases, we likely would have made the budgeted profit. <there was applause>

Sergeants – 56 people attended the site, 43 adults and 13 kids. Biffies cancelled at the last moment, staffing issues with Maple Ridge parks caused short term insurance to be required. We lost \$260.00 on the event, but it was a lovely event. Her Excellency was very pleased at the results of the event, with the populace learning about the Sergeantry process.

Upcoming events:

TOA planning is already taking place, Ms. Claire, MIC will be Oberst Luther. Merchant turnout will be concentrated on, to assist in making the event. Asking each army to bring a marshall to the field to assist. We do need more volunteers for next year for gate etc. Next year, we may have to pay Lionsdale for use, or make alternate arrangements for the use of the land. The site did get rave reviews from the battle fans due to the site lines. It is possible the bowl may be a lake next year however so a venue change may be made. As well, a deputy would be loved to be fostered and trained to move forwards.

Baroness's Birthday – a bid has been placed by Caitrin, to have the event at the Cloverdale Fairgrounds, using the two buildings (with having to be out of one by 3pm for wrestling). The banquet will be a traditional potluck, likely in lieu of the formal banquet. The formal banquet may be moved to February, to go with the “cerebral” defenders. At this time there are no other bids for the November date. A theme of an ode to Margaret would be appreciated for any A&S/Bardic entries. Kenna will co-autocrat the event.

Next years events, with the warning from the Seneschale – if you don't get a bid in 8 months in advance for tier one, 6 for tier 2, 3 for tier 3, the event will be cancelled!
